Anna is the Ratio Christi Cults and New Religions Specialist as well as Area Ministry Director over the great state of Tennessee and Chapter Director for the University of Tennessee Knoxville. She is Theological Director over a center specializing in mental health therapies and interventions where she treats victims of religious and spiritual abuse alongside a staff of fellow therapists.

She holds both a Masters of Biblical Studies from Reformed Theological Seminary as well as a soon-tobe Masters of Psychology of Coercive Control from the University of Salford Manchester. Her work with the crew in the UK includes having authored the first psychometric tool for measuring spiritual abuse in demonic deliverance settings. She has a heart for the myriads of people who have incurred complex psychological traumas in religious and spiritual settings which are more than often damaging Biblebased cult groups.

Derek and Dulce Johnson

Derek and Dulce Johnson left a spiritually abusive church in 2021 after being there for ten and nine years respectively. Since leaving they have invested much time and energy into learning more about cultic control, the harm of spiritual abuse, and ministering to victims of other high-control organizations.

Dulce is the face behind The Honest Messy Life, an online space where she shares her story of spiritual abuse as a way to bring awareness to the issues many churches face. This platform has given victims comfort in knowing they are not alone, and helped them put words to their experiences. Derek has helped Dulce behind the scenes by creating content, providing guidance, and offering wisdom. They both value taking the time to rightly understand scripture in both its context and application as a way to combat abuse in church and equip individuals to discern right from wrong themselves.





Holly Pivec

Holly Pivec is a blogger, author, and speaker, as well as a pastor's wife and homeschooling mom. She has a master's degree in Christian apologetics from Biola University, where she also served as university editor for nearly a decade.
